## Review and Approval of Previous Minutes

The minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed and approved. The minutes are available on the GIS home webpage.

## Status of Projects Tasks

### Projects in Progress

#### Sub Review- Committee

#### Parcel Maintenance

Roger L commented the City View application needs to have the parcel LRSN field id's to be able to assign a permit, and since assigning the id didn't happen until the subdivision was recorded he has begun speaking with the Assessors requesting of them to assign parcel ids after final approval at sub review. General discussion followed about the current process

and other scenarios. General discussion about scanners/plotters and scanned plats for the subdivisions.

Laura H. commented that Ryan Key is continuing to edit the parcel layer as normal.

Larry C. commented that the assessor parcel text data is not useable for a point layer, and they are willing to help clean up the data. There was general discussion about the addressing of parcels, and structures in the CAMA data. Roger L. suggested starting an addressing project.

## **Water and Sewer Utility Conversion**

Laura H reported the numbers are the same 190 sections for sewer and 43 sections for water have had some editing out of about 300 sections.

## **Storm Water Project**

Laura H. commented they are in maintenance mode, with about 41 -51 % completed.

## **Street Addressing**

Laura H. commented: Old National Bank Dr was renamed to Hirsch Rd. The newly opened University Parkway has been added to Central Dispatches database, but not yet to the network we are still waiting on the cad drawing in order to properly place the new section of road. Roger commented he has received another mobile home park drawing, making a total of 4 mobile home park drawings received this year. We had a general discussion about using GPS to collect these apartment and mobile home parks as address points.

## **Arc IMS Websites**

Laura stated no new sites, there was a general discussion about the new Building commission website style. There is a tutorial button on the Building commission site for further information.

## **GPS**

Linda F has been in contact with Vincennes University; they have a CORS station and have been helping Linda set ours in the standard format.

## **2005 State Color Ortho Photography**

Laura commented that the delivery date is still set for the middle of January, but we have not yet received them. We do know of one "bad" tile that has foliage issues, but we will receive all tiles and replace the "bad" with a new tile, when available.
