Sub Review- Committee

Parcel Maintenance

Ryan K reported he has been focusing his edits on the subdivision he provided a listing of the subdivisions he had completed.

Water and Sewer Utility Conversion

Laura H reported the same comment as last month. As follows the sewer editing staff is now working more in the rural areas, and new construction areas and these edits take a bit longer due to not having cad line work in those areas to use as an overlay. Water side of edits stayed the same.

City Storm Water Project

Laura H. commented they are continuing to enter their data into the model and are about 70% complete.

County Storm Water Project

Laura H commented the County Engineers Office has begun a new project of mapping the county storm inlets this project is very similar to the City Engineers storm mapping project. They are also creating a bridge layer, and are almost completed. This will become a new layer on the X drive for the enterprise use. There was a general discussion about current bridge status, and where to find bridge information.

Street Addressing

Laura H. commented: we adjusted the ranges of a few streets: 1600 blk of Shoshoni, 2900 blk of Southeast Blvd, increased range of Barbara Jane and Rochelle Drives. We corrected a mislabeled driveway to be the 11700 blk of High Meadow, also removed the vacated section of the 200 blk of 8th street.

Laura H reported the County Surveyors are continuing to work on the GPS unit.

Planning (Zoning): Dave had a meeting last week with staff from Municipal and staff from Area Plan to review the planning module which did meet with Area Plan's business process, with very few modifications needed.

It will be a parcel based work order system, using the GIS aspect of the module.
