Sub Review- Committee

Parcel Maintenance

Ryan K reported he has been focusing his edits on the subdivisions. Philip would like to set up a meeting to go over condos and improvement only codes.

Water and Sewer Utility Conversion

Laura H reported the same numbers of quarter/quarter sections have been edited for both water and sewer sides of the projects.

City Storm Water Project

Laura H. commented that they are continuing to enter their data into the model.

County Storm Water Project

Laura H commented that the County Engineers Office has begun a new project of mapping the county storm inlets. This project is very similar to the City Engineers storm mapping project. We have completed the geodatabase that they will be entering their data into. The next phase will be training on geometric networks

Street Addressing

Laura H. commented on the following edits: Stone Crest Subdivision sections seven and eight- which extended Rolling Meadow's Dr and Wayland Dr, added new Trailstone Dr. Also added was Saint Charles Cove subdivision- which extended Heard St, added new Heard Court, and Juniper Court. Sugar Mill Creek Town homes Complex had a few range edits. And one new street that was added was Soccer Lane, located at the Goebel Soccer complex.

Arc IMS Websites

Laura H reported that we have added the Commissioners Tax Certificate Sale website, located on the GIS home page. This site displays information about property the county has to offer for tax sale. No sale date has been set yet. Greg Grabner is also working on the AVL (Automated Vehicle Locator) website; this site will show where the county highway work trucks are located throughout the day. Greg is also working on an internal website to display the locations of runs called into the Animal Control officers.

Laura H reported the County Surveyors are continuing to work with Luke Brazdys of Vincennes University on compiling the GPS unit.

Animal Control: Completed: Updated the citation tracking system by adding a new report, which will track revenue based on citations.

Code Enforcement: Completed: Working with Municipal, to add a new function that will automatically assign the inspector based on type of call, and by location of call.

Permitting & Inspections: In configuration phase: Dave B reported that Municipal is configuring the module for contractor licensing needs.
