Review and Approval of Previous Minutes

Sub Review- Committee

Parcel Maintenance

Philip commented he is continuing to edit on subdivision, minor edits are on hold until subdivisions are caught up, if you have questions please forward to Ryan Key.

Utility Conversion

Laura H reported the same numbers of quarter/quarter sections have been edited for both water and sewer sides of the projects.

City Storm Water Project

Laura H. commented that they are continuing to enter their data into the model. Cris Cottom reported they have entered about 100 miles of pipe and approximately 5000 structures, they still have culverts and ditches to enter, and this is a long term project.

County Storm Water Project

Laura H commented that the County Engineers Office has begun a new project of mapping the county storm inlets. This project is very similar to the City Engineers storm mapping project. Thus far we have had two training sessions with Tom Goodman, Dave Castrale and Pat Seib, with more training scheduled next week.

Street Addressing

Laura H. commented on the following edits: Heartland Section two, which includes an apartment complex Wolf Creek Village, includes a new street called Cub Cove also extended Blessing Way and Wolf Creek Court. Another new Subdivision is Mystic Creek which included Mystic Creek Court and Mystic Creek Drive. Also Falcon Ridge Subdivision was added which includes new streets Merlin Place, Kestrel Court, Peregrine Dr and Aplomado Dr. Spelling edit for Eichoff road to the proper spelling of Eickhoff.

Arc IMS Websites

Greg G reported the newest site is the AVL website, which shows static points of where the trucks were the day prior. Greg also stated during the summer he plans to update the APC website to the newer Freeance template. Laura commented to check the Sex offender site; we are always adding/moving offender points throughout the city and county.

GPS

Laura H reported the County Surveyors are continuing to work with Luke Brazdys of Vincennes University on compiling the GPS unit.

2005 State Color Ortho Photography

Greg announced we have received the images!! We received them last week and have been placing them on the network, currently they are in an sde dataset, similar to the 2000 black & white images. They will also be on the Y drive under the Orthos folder; the grid shapefile is also located in the same folder. We have been reviewing the tiles for accuracy and completeness. We will still be receiving additional layers from the state such as the DEM, and DSM. Philip asked about new contours or building footprints from the new images, at this time we have not planned to create these layers. Laura L asked about surrounding

counties images, at this time Vanderburgh was the only county delivered. But in time, we will get the surrounding counties images and place on the network. Laura L commented that Henderson KY will be receiving new aerials soon, and hopes to receive them. Philip reported that Pictometry has been speaking with some of the township assessors, for possible re-flights in the future with purchases of current photos.

Traffic Signal Project

Laura H reported this is in the beginning phases, I did send a data dictionary for review, and expect to have the geodatabase by the end of the month. This project will be mapping the traffic signal equipment. This information once completed will be supplied to the IUPPS Call Before You Dig Program.

City View Projects

Dave Bottomley reports for these projects.

Animal Control: Completed: He had a meeting with Susie Craig of Central Dispatch to go over integrating the animal control, building commission, and DMD or any other city view data into the CAD system. This would provide information of dangerous animal locations, or building permits issuances to incoming calls.

Code Enforcement: Completed: Municipal will be conducting training in the coming weeks. Dave will be working on online permitting forms, such as sewer taps and building permit

Permitting & Inspections: In configuration phase: Dave B reported that Municipal has configured the application and will be doing testing. (Tape was slurred)

Citizen Complaint: - on hold

Planning (Zoning): Configuration: Municipal is finalizing the module. Training is the next phase.

Work Order/Fleet Management: Completed Design: Dave commented that there are now fifty additional licenses. They can now deploy to City garage, County Garage, BPW. This application is a vehicle maintenance tracking software; any other city/county offices can begin to use this application, only a license is required. Cost for one license is 2000. one time and 400 a year maintenance.

AVL Project

Greg G stated that the website has been released, but we are still working on other aspects of the AVL management, such as monitoring speeds, locating vehicles and reports.
