Review and Approval of Previous Minutes

Status of Projects Tasks

Projects in Progress

Parcel Maintenance

Ryan prepared a reporting document showing the edits he has made since the last meeting. Greg and Laura offered to help create a gis map to show where the edits have been made; we had a general discussion on how to report his completed work for this meeting and then to his supervisor. Subdivision edits are on hold until the easement layer can be modified. Ryan continues to make the minor edits; he has completed the all edits in Center and Armstrong Townships, and is currently working in German Township.

Water and Sewer Utility

Laura H reported that last month Rick and Rodney were working on updating their map books; no new quarter sections have been completed. Roger asked about completed quarter sections, being available to the enterprise, Greg reported they have an internal website to view their edits. Greg spoke about the city engineer's storm water project using some of the utility layers as well in the future.

Addressing and Corrections

Laura H. reported the updates this month for the 2000Streets layer. We updated thirteen address ranges, which is general maintenance. Roger asked about parcel point addressing, he reported his code enforcement project would require that data. Philip and Laura replied no one is currently working on point addressing at this time.

Arc IMS Websites

Greg G reported the County Commissioner Tax Certificate Sale was last week, and was very successful, and since the sale is over the website has been removed. Laura L asked about how many hits a website received, Greg reported we can add counters to new websites we create. Laura H reported the Heavy Trash Pickup program in session check out the website your pick up date. Philip suggested running a topology on that heavy trash layer.

Storm Water Project

Greg G. reported the pilot area has been completed and they are now inputting their data into the model. Greg has completed an internal website for their data model. Roger asked about the County Engineers status, Greg replied he will use the same model as the city, but nothing has begun yet.

Laura H reported from Linda Freeman, she is contacting CORS and NGS to submit our GPS data to them.

2005 State Color Ortho Photography
