Parcel Maintenance

Ryan stated all edits in German Township have been completed and now working in Knight Township. Heritage Park phase 1, and Colby Minor are now added to the subdivisions. Jim McReynolds has been creating the easement polygons for faster editing. Also, Jim has been updating the book and page number for the subdivision layer. Laura L also mentioned that

hopefully APC could get the scanned image attached to the subdivision layer. Susie Craig commented she may begin to use the subdivision layer in the Computer Aided Dispatch system.

Addressing and Corrections

2005 State Color Ortho Photography

City View Projects

Animal Control: In Production Phase: Dave commented the application is up and running for several weeks now. In the GIS portion I recently compiled a list of street names that are not in the Assessor data, such as apartments or condos as a separate search engine.

Code Enforcement: In Design Phase: Municipal provided training to the DMD code enforcement folks, they tested the application for a week, Municipal came back for two days to get the results of the testing, to see what worked what didn't work and what needed to be changed. There will be another week of training the beginning of December and the go live date is scheduled for December 15, 2005.
