## **Subcommittee Reports**

### **Plat Maintenance**

Carolyn G asked about the schedule of updates, Laura reported that parcel updates have been updated 1-6, 2-10, we used to get parcel updates from the previous editor on a two week schedule. Note that parcels updates should occur on a weekly basis.

## Status of Projects Tasks

### Projects in Progress

#### Water and Sewer Utility

Laura H. reported they are continuing to reposition features. Laura reported there are 40 of the 500 quarter sections that have been edited on the water side, and 185 of the 300 quarter sections for the sewer side.

#### Addressing and Corrections

Laura H. reported that there are many updates this month. Working with Jim McReynolds of APC, he has granted access to using the CAD files. Laura has added several new subdivisions to the 2000streets, Asbury Sub Section 1, Cookman Way, Boardwalk Dr, Kingsley Ct: Fawn Creek Section E- Buck Trail, Fawn Creek: Central Dispatch editor Susie Craig updated the display name field with Alley and Private Dr: Name change Harbour Ct to Aruba Ct.

#### Zoning

Laura H reported Area Plan Commission has not reported any errors/issues, they continue to use and maintain the zoning layer and website.

#### Arc IMS Websites

Laura H. reported on the Vanderburgh County Sheriff Sex Offender website; they are continuing to update the offender database. This website should be released to the public soon. We reported last month that EUTS has a new Traffic Volume website on the local internet for their office use. Laura reported last month a new internal site, for Snow Routes, which shows the city, state, and proposed county snow routes.
