## Review and Approval of Previous Minutes

The minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed and approved with the noted grammatical errors.

## Subcommittee Reports

### Parcel Conversion Project

Greg G. reported they are ending the training sessions with the new editor Ryan Key, today is the beginning of maintenance for parcel line work. Laura Lamb will be reviewing his edits for a few weeks. Phillip B. reported he will be updating the counter ArcReader maps to the new SDE connections of the data. Greg G reported Knight Townships ArcGIS software has been installed with a concurrent and a single seat license of the software.

## Status of Projects Tasks

### Projects in Progress

#### Water and Sewer Utility

Laura H. reported there have been 199 of the 300 quarter sections for the sewer side which is up from 187 last month. Rodney noted he is seeing other people's versions for other datasets, when trying to change versions in ArcMap; he must use ArcCatalog now to change versions.

#### Addressing and Corrections

Laura H. reported the updates this month for the 2000Streets layer. We added Carrington Meadows Phase Two; including streets named Thornhill, Whitlow, Balboa and Pondella. Added Amhearst Manor Sect. Three Phase Two; including streets named Cornell Ct, Oaklyn and Harvard Ct. Also we extended Interchange Rd both the North and South segments. Carolyn R. commented on the recent local news item about an address miscommunication which resulted in a historical building being demolished, she has since contacted the Building Commission and her department head, to create an ordinance to help alleviate some of the addressing concerns.

#### Arc IMS Websites

Greg G reported a new Tax Certificate website, which focuses on parcels up for sale by the County Commissioners. You must agree to the disclaimer pages first then the map appears.

#### Storm Water Project

Greg G. reported he has been working with the City Engineer's Office; they have received a new computer and a new intern and have been setting up the equipment. They are currently working within the pilot area of the project.

#### 2005 State Color Ortho Photography

Laura H reported no news yet from the State, but they are expected to be delivered late summer or early fall. Now we are preparing server space for the data, expecting to be about one terabyte of data. Rodney S asked about the size of each tile, these new tiles will be smaller than the current tiles, from a one mile square image to a 4000 ft square image.

David B. stated for the Code Enforcement project they are in the data conversion process. For the animal control project he has been adding additional functionality to the application and are populating the GIS side of the software with the parcel information
